Q. What is my role in Rooting & Reaching?

Q. Can I give toward my commitment once a week, once a month, or once a year?

A. Yes, gifts to fulfill your commitment can be made in a way most convenient to you over the three-year period.

Q. If necessary, can I change my commitment?

A. Yes, you can adjust your commitment at any time. Special arrangements will be made for you to revise and review.

Q. Can I contribute something other than cash?

A. Yes! You can contribute items such as real estate, stocks or bonds, life insurance policies, cash values of policies, antiques, works of art, jewelry, coin or stamp collections, income tax refunds, etc.

Q. When should I start to bring my gifts for this new effort?

A. November 15th is “First Fruits Sunday” when we ask everyone to bring their initial offerings to this campaign. However, you can begin giving your gift at any time.

Q. When will construction begin?
